# GAPPS TLF#56: 21<sup>st</sup> - 22<sup>nd</sup> March 2023 via Zoom Workstreams

### Organisational PM Capability

At GAPPS TLF#54 several experts shared their knowledge of and experience with organisational PM capability standards, guides, models, and excellence frameworks. At TLF#55 it was agreed that although there are many models out there, they are either proprietary, not readily available, or don't provide a practical basis for assessment and improvement. We identified desirable criteria and with this lens, at TLF#56, we will start work on a freely available assessment model for OPM capability by looking at the approach and coverage of existing frameworks.

### PPPM Standards – Update & Mapping

Standards for PPPM are evolving. Learn what is happening in PPPM standards development and contribute to the GAPPS comparative mapping of global standards and qualifications.

## **Getting Stuff Done**

When GAPPS looked at reviewing its Project Manager Standards, they decided it was time to completely re-think the competencies required to Get Stuff Done in a volatile, uncertain, complex and ambiguous world. A high-level guide has been completed and we are now looking at it's application in different contexts.

#### Program Manager Framework update

GAPPS Program Manager Guiding Framework was published in 2011 and it is time to have another look at it and bring it up do date. As a starting point we have mapped other Program Management Standards against the GAPPS framework to provide insight into possible gaps and directions for improvement. At this TLF we will review feedback from public review.
